NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH: Vandalism and theft has occurred in our subdivision. Two trucks in their driveways were broken into. One truck was stolen and personal items were stolen from the other truck. These are under police investigation including an incident at Quail Creek and Buena Vista. The Board of Directors is asking residents to be proactive and help keep the neighborhood safe by being watchful for suspicious activity especially after dark and calling 911 to make a police report. Try to get a license number and a good description of the vehicle. To make ourselves less vulnerable for home burglaries, do not leave garage doors open, do not leave garage door openers in vehicles not garaged. If you have cars parked in the driveway or street, take all valuables out and leave your outside lights on. Do not let newspapers or mail accumulate in your absence. However, if you see two or more newspapers in a neighbor's driveway, perhaps you could pick up the newspapers and move them out of sight. If you are going to be away, let a neighbor know of your absence. Do everything you can to give the impression your house is occupied.
