President Scott held a question and answer session after the election of officers and several issues were discussed.

WARD PROPERTY: President Bob Scott advised at the annual meeting that he had received a telephone call from the Ward family expressing concern that individuals are riding bikes and walking across their private property on the east side of our subdivision.

ALLIED WASTE - YARD WASTE AND RECYCLING PROGRAMS: The board apologizes for the confusion over the billing rates for those that have recycling and or yard waste services through Allied Waste. The three-year contract allows for no more than a 4% increase annually plus applicable fuel fees. When Allied quoted the rates for 2011 to the Board they failed to include the additional amount for fuel fees. As a result the letter from the Board in December 2010 quoted a lower rate. The correct amount for Yard Waste is \$92.00 and \$69.53 for Recycling. Both fees include the applicable fuel fees. The Yard Waste program runs April 1 through November 30. Pick up is every Monday. Allied Waste provides a cart for grass, leaves, and garden waste which should be loose in the cart (not in bags). Recycling service is every other week on Thursday. A container is provided. Both the Yard Waste and Recycling programs are paid directly to Allied Waste by the home owner. The telephone number for Allied Waste is 417-865-1717.
